



Michael Dennis Coursey

August 15, 1950 - October 7, 2010

Michael Dennis Coursey of Queenstown, MD died at his home Thursday evening surrounded by his family, after a long battle with cancer. He was 60.

Born August 15, 1950 in Grasonville, MD, he was the son of the late, William Ray and Isabel Hoxter Coursey. Mike grew up in Grasonville and graduated from Queen Anne's County High School in 1969. He married the former, Linda Dale Morris on February 27, 1971. Mike was drafted into the Army in 1970 and served during the Vietnam War, where he received the Army Commendation Medal. Following his discharge from the Army, Mike worked for Gerardi Brothers in Denton, MD and for Centreville Electric. He worked many years for Charles Karmosky Architectural Assoc. as a draftsman before beginning his own business, Mike Coursey Drafting.

Mike loved music and enjoyed playing the guitar, drums, tin whistle and recorder. He was especially fond of Celtic music. Mike also enjoyed carving and various other types of handiwork. He was an active member of Calvary United Methodist Church where he enjoyed singing and playing his guitar.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Coursey is survived by a daughter, Katie Rae Coursey of Queenstown; two sisters, Nancy Mende of Grasonville and Marsha Smith of Ridgely; three brothers, Dwight Coursey of Grasonville, Glen Coursey of Delaware and Jody Coursey of Easton, and several nieces and

nephews.

Funeral services will be held at Calvary United Methodist Church, Queenstown, MD on Tuesday, October 12, 2010 at 11:00 AM. Friends and family may call at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Centreville, MD on Monday evening from 6 – 8 PM.
