Michael Patrick Youell, Sr. of Grasonville, MD died peacefully on Wednesday, May 19, 2010 at his home surrounded by his children. He was 63.

Michael was born on October 13, 1946 in Takoma Park, MD, the son of the late, Francis and Evelyn Irene Teague Youell. He was a graduate of Glen Burnie High School, Class of 1965. Michael enlisted in the Navy, serving for four years with a year in Iceland before receiving an honorable discharge.
