Michele graduated from Queen Anne's County High School in Centreville, MD in 1984, where she was an exceptional thespian in many school plays which showed off her wicked sense of humor and comedic timing. She later graduated from AACC in Nursing where she excelled in her field. Michele's love of life led her to become a travel nurse and dive into many sectors of the nursing profession, from ER, to Cardiac, to Neonatal ICU, to a Concierge nurse, then finally to a Charge nurse, where she oversaw other nurses and was responsible for training staff in ICU nursing.
