Michelle Lynn Bathras died on February 24, 2014, at her home in Stevensville, MD, surrounded by her loving family. She was 50.

Michelle was born on July 7, 1963, in Annapolis, MD, the daughter of Robert Lewis of Denton, MD, and the late Dolores Howe Lewis. She graduated from Glen Burnie High School, Class of 1981. Michelle married Jeffery Bathras in 1983, and she began her career at Bello Machre in 1984, where she worked for 30 years. Her last 15 years with Bello Machre were spent as Vice President and Chief Operating Officer, helping to enrich the lives of those with developmental disabilities. In 2013 Michelle was chosen as the year's honoree of the Disability Awareness Award from the Anne Arundel County Commission on Disability Issues for her work.

Michelle enjoyed time spent with her family on their boat, taking in the scenery of Maryland with her husband on their motorcycle, and travelling to exotic locations on cruises. She lived her life by a simple rule- carpe diem- seize the day.

Michelle Bathras is survived by her husband, Jeffery Bathras; daughters Sarah Sklanka and her husband Jason of Stevensville, MD; Kaitlyn Bathras of Baltimore, MD; sons Justin Bathras of Stevensville, MD; Josh Bathras of Stevensville, MD; Keith Bratley of Greensboro, MD; brother Martin Lewis of

Severna Park, MD; sister Kimberly Bolan of Apple Valley, CA; and grandson Brayden Moran.

She leaves us with such sadness but a wonderful legacy of gifted, inspired, intelligent and heartfelt service. Her thirty year presence with Bello Machre will always be treasured. She was an inspiration to us all. Staff at Bello Machre will likely ask for a long time, when the going gets tough and complicated, what would Michelle do? Thank you Michelle and thank you to your family and your Bello Machre family who obviously provided you with much loving support.

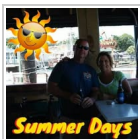
