Michael F. "Mike" Hinefelt of Rock Hall, Maryland died at his home on October 3, 2009. He was 51.

He was the son of the late, Alfred Franklin "Bud" Hinefelt who died on December 12, 2008 and the son of Patricia Jeffers Hinefelt of Rock Hall, MD. He is the husband of Deborah Mary Kinder Hinefelt, whom he married October 16, 1982.

Mr. Hinefelt was educated in Rock Hall and at a young age went to work as a waterman, crabbing and oystering. He then worked with his father's company, Variety Marine Construction as a pile driver, building piers, bulkheads, and other marine projects. Following his father's retirement, Mike went back to work on the water until diabetes forced him into early retirement.

He loved to be on the water whether crabbing, oystering, fishing or for recreation, Mike also loved family get togethers, woodworking and spending time with his grandchildren.

He was a member of Rock Hall United Methodist Church.

In addition to his wife and mother he is survived by his children, Michael Jason Hinefelt of Rock Hall, MD, and Krystal Lee Hinefelt of Rock Hall, MD; a

sister, Sharon Lee "Sherrie" Porter and her husband, Larry of Sebring, FL; grandchildren, Tabitha, Ashten, Haley, Savannah, and Arizona. He is also survived by nieces and nephews.
