



## Mildred Lavina LeCates

Mildred Lavina LeCates of Chestertown, MD, died at Magnolia Hall Nursing Center in Chestertown on August 7, 2000. She was 95.

Born near Chestertown, on July 6, 1905, she was the daughter of the late George V. Hatcherson and the late Eva Downey Hatcherson Lee. Mrs. LeCates graduated from Chestertown High School and went to work for C&P Telephone Company in 1927. In 1929, she married Conrad "Simms" Le Cates. She worked for C&P Telephone Company as an operator for 40 years retiring in 1967. In 1994, her husband predeceased her.

Mrs. LeCates was a lifetime member of the Telephone Pioneers of America. She was also a member of the Order of the Eastern Star Chapter #86 for 55 years where she served as Past Worthy Matron, Deputy Grand Lecturer from 1961-1963, and Grand Representative to Utah from 1967 until 1971.

Nieces and nephews survive her. She was predeceased by a brother, Robert R. Hatcherson, Sr., and a sister, Mabel Taylor.

Graveside services will be held on Wednesday August 9, 2000, at 1 p.m. at Chester Cemetery.
