Mildred Elizabeth Leaverton of Easton, Maryland, formerly of Fairlee, MD, died on Saturday, July 27, 2002 at Talbot Hospice House. She was 87.

Born in Baltimore, MD on May 27, 1915, she was the daughter of the late George Mertz and Sarah Warfield Warehime as well as the stepdaughter of the late Reason Warehime. After graduating from High School she resided in Baltimore, where she married Oscar S. Leaverton. They soon moved back to the Eastern Shore of Maryland and resided in Fairlee. Mrs. Leaverton worked with her husband as O and M Newspaper Service in the Chestertown and Rock Hall areas, until the late 1970's. She also worked for close friends, Joe and Flossie Strong, as a hostess with the Old Wharf Restaurant in Chestertown, MD. On June 29, 1974, her husband predeceased her. Mrs. Leaverton attended St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Chestertown, Md.

Due to her love of the beach, she resided in Rehoboth, Delaware for several years and she enjoyed knitting and crocheting and she also volunteered at Easton Memorial Hospital.

Mrs. Leaverton is survived by a daughter, Carole Abruzzese of Oxford, MD; a son, David Franklin Leaverton of Centreville, MD; a sister, Lillian Brandau of Westminster, MD; a brother, Fred Warehime of Riverview, FL; 5 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.
