



Mildred Lorraine Warner

May 25, 1918 - November 19, 2015

Lorraine Warner, age 97, passed away peacefully Thursday, November 19, 2015, at her home.

She was born in Rosebud, AR, on May 25, 1918, to Hassel and Viola Lee Troxell. She grew up on a farm in Missouri after her father lost his furniture store during The Depression. In the 1940's, when her parents moved to Redondo Beach, CA, she followed them and immediately fell in love with the lifestyle and weather, and stayed for forty years.

Lorraine loved clothes, fashion, and working with people, so she found a job in a woman's clothing store. After several years, she wanted to try something different, so she took a job at Metlox Pottery, in the factory making dishes. She moved up through the ranks and retired in 1984, as a Customer Service Representative.

After her husband Harry Warner died in 1985, she moved from California to Yardley, PA, to live with her daughter and son-in-law, where she was able to pursue her love of gardening, cooking, and taking care of her dog, Kayla. She moved to Easton with them in 2010.

Lorraine is survived by her daughter, Beverly and son-in-law Chuck Radvan; their daughter, Kimberly Jerome and her husband Rob; and a brother, Jerry

Troxell, in CA. She was preceded in death by her granddaughter, Stephanie Radvan.

Services will be held at Grace Lutheran Church, 111 Brookletts Ave., Easton, with Pastor Karen Larson officiating, on Monday, November 30, 2015, at 11 a.m., with lunch to follow in the Fellowship Hall. Burial will be private at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton, MD.
