Mildred Ellen Stevens, of Easton formerly of Trappe, went to be with the Lord at the Memorial Hospital At Easton on Tuesday, October 2, 2001. She was 86.

Born near Preston on April 3, 1915, she was the daughter of the late William Caulk and Lizzie Andrew Harding. She graduated from Preston High School in June of 1933. On Dec. 23, 1933, she married Everett M. Stevens, a Talbot County farmer. They made their home in the Trappe area where he died on October 10, 1984. She moved to the Easton area in 1990.
