Mildred Elmire Pyper, of Easton, MD died Monday, August 6, 2001 at William Hill Manor, Easton. She was 94.

Born in Easton, December 16, 1906, she was the daughter of the late Thomas Shreve and Elizabeth Almira McNeal Marvel. After attending public school, she, in April of 1927, married George Dudley Pyper. They made their home in Talbot County where, for many years, she was the secretary and bookkeeper for her husband in his business, G. Dudley Pyper, Farm Equipment.
