Mildred I. Kunze, of Easton, died at Talbot Hospice House on Wednesday, May 3, 2006. She was 95.

Born at Wye Island, Queen Anne's County, MD, March 18, 1911, she was the daughter of the late Perry Lee and Ida Pinder Whitby. After attending public school in Centreville, she moved to Marcus Hook, PA with her sister where she worked in a 5 & 10 cent store.

She later moved to Easton where she worked in the local 5 & 10 Cent Store until just after her marriage in September of 1930 to Armin E. Kunze. They made their home in Easton until moving to Baltimore during World War II. Following the war, they returned to Easton where she owned a grocery store and then worked with her husband in the auto repair business.

A member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton and the Auxiliary of the Easton Volunteer Fire Department where she had been a member of over 60 years, she enjoyed being on the water, fishing and crabbing.

Mr. Kunze died January 31, 1985.

Surviving are two sisters, Frances Morris of Cordova who was more like her daughter and Mary Schaefer of Denton. She is also survived by Rick, Greg and Jeff Morris and their families, who were like grandchildren to her and

numerous nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, May 5, 2006 at 2:00 p.m. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to service.
