Millicent "Millie" H. Marker died Tuesday, January 9, 2019, at the Resorts at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD. She was 95.

Millie was born March 18, 1923, in Philadelphia, PA, the daughter of the late Louis and Ethel Heisley. Millie married Charles Marker, Jr., in 1941, and they were happily married for 62 years until his death in 2003. Millie and Charles moved from Springfield, PA, to Galena, MD, in 1960. Over the years, Millie worked as a lab technician for American Viscose, she was the postmaster in Galena for 13 years, she and Charles owned and operated Galena Hardware from 1963-1978 years and most recently she worked as an office assistant for Marker Systems Inc. and retired in 1998. She was a member of Olivet United Methodist Church, the Busy Bees in Galena, and the Galena Lions Club. Millie loved to sew and crochet, playing BINGO and most of all spending time with her family and friends.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by two sisters, Thelma Meyers, Louise Means and one brother, Bruce Heisley.

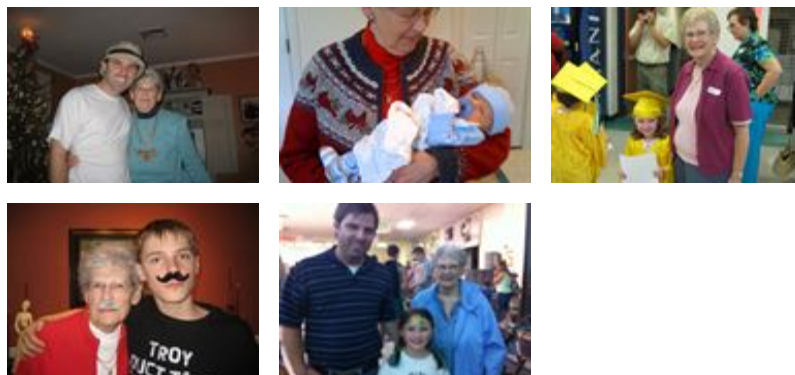
