



Milton N. Agreen

September 8, 1909 - June 1, 2016

Milton N. Agreen of Easton, MD, formerly of Ormond Beach, FL, died on June 1, 2016, at the Dixon House. He was 106.

Born in Woodbridge, NJ, on September 8, 1909, he was the son of the late Gustave Carl and Marie Simpfendorf Agreen.

After graduating from the Woodbridge High School in NJ, he attended Pace College in NY for two years. From 1942-1965, he worked as a cost accountant for Alcoa Aluminum Company in Edgewater, NJ. He worked briefly for a truck trailer company before being employed by the U.S. Postal Service as a mail carrier, then postal clerk before retiring in 1975. For many years, he sang for the John Harms Choral Group in New York.

After retiring, he moved from Bergenfield, NJ, to Ormond Beach, FL, where he worked part-time as a tax preparer. In 1997, he moved to Maryland and for the last ten years has lived at the Dixon House in Easton.

Mr. Agreen is survived by three sons, Robert C. Agreen of New Castle, DE, Russell W. Agreen (Linda) of Denton, MD, and Bruce H. Agreen (Rina) of Jacksonville, FL; seven grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, Annemarie Eckloff Agreen, and daughter-in-law, Margaret Agreen.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, June 8, 2016, at 3 PM, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior from 2-3 PM.

Inurnment will be at the Oxford Columbarium, Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD, at a later date.
