January 4, 1933 - November 25, 2015

Milton Crossland Irvin, 82, of Easton, MD, died on Wednesday, November 25, 2015, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton. He was born in Arlington, VA, on January 4, 1933, son of the late King Milton Irvin and Ruth Lucas Irvin.

Raised in Arlington, VA, a graduate of Washington Lee High School and a member of the 1950 national championship crew team, Milt graduated from Ohio Wesleyan University in 1955 and served in United States Air Force attaining the rank of Captain. Following his military service, Milt received an MBA from American University and began his distinguished Washington, DC, area real estate development career with Edmund J. Bennett Associates. Milt was a founding principal of Croyder Irvin and Company, and of CIH Properties, Inc. where he served as Chairman. Over the course of his career, Milt was responsible for the creation of a number of premier residential communities, consisting of over one thousand homes. Following his retirement Milt moved to Maryland's Eastern Shore. An avid enthusiast of history, novels and nature, Milt passed his passion for sailing and the Chesapeake Bay to his children. He was a friend to many, a gentleman, and a beloved son and father.

He is survived by two sons, Douglas Irvin of Annapolis and Bruce Irvin of Davidsonville, MD, and five grandchildren, Storrie, Alders, Isla, Jack and David.

A visitation will be held on Saturday, December 5, 2015, from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison Street in Easton.
