Milton Robert “Bobby” Pierson, Jr., of Chester, MD, died Saturday November 16, 2013, at Corsica Hills Nursing Center in Centreville, MD. He was 86.

Born on October 23, 1927, in Grasonville, MD, the son of the late Mina Smith Pierson and Milton Robert Pierson, Sr. He attended school in Queen Anne’s County. Bobby was drafted into the Army at age 18 and would serve during World War II. After he was honorably discharged, he returned home to Grasonville. He was a waterman and also worked part-time with Thomas E. Pierson & Sons and Jerry F. Pierson’s Plumbing and Heating businesses. Bobby was known to be a very good painter and worked with Mr. Larrimore, a popular house painter. He also painted many boats at Medford Thomas’s Boat Yard.

He liked hunting, fishing, boating with his friends, listening to country music on his radio, and spending time talking with his family and lifelong friends on his front porch. He loved his family, and especially enjoyed spending time with the four different generations of children in the family. Bobby was always interested in their lives. He enjoyed hearing about their school activities, sports, fun activities, and their jobs. His greatest love was having pictures of the family and their families, as he always made sure he had treats available when they visited.

In addition to a large extended family, he is survived by sisters, Catherine Pierson Heim and Gloria Pierson Kelley and her husband, Louis all of Stevensville, MD, and brother, Jerry F. Pierson and his wife Bonnie of Chester, MD. He was predeceased by his brother, Thomas E. Pierson and a nephew Martin A. Pierson.
