Milton Cooper Knox of East New Market, MD, formerly of Easton, MD died on Monday, December 3, 2001 at Dorchester General Hospital, Cambridge, MD. He was 80.

Born in Wilmington, DE, January 16, 1921, he was the son of the late Milton Bartlett Paul and Daisy Pearl McQuay Knox. As a child he moved with his family to Talbot County where he attended public school. He served in the Maryland National Guard and the United States Army for a brief time during WWII. A carpenter, he had spent his lifetime in the construction business, including twenty-eight years with Wm. A. Knox, contractor, before retiring in 1983.

A former member of the Talbot Rod and Gun Club, he was also a member of the Talbot Post 70, American Legion.

Mr. Knox wife, the former Anna Mae Marshall whom he married in July of 1940, died in March of 1997.

Mr. Knox is survived by a sister, Daisy P. Daubach of Easton, MD and a brother, Thomas R. Knox of Queenstown, MD.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, December 7, 2001 at 11:00 AM at the

Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton, MD.
