



## Milton Pearce Merryman

Milton Pearce Merryman, a resident of Easton since 2000, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Monday, February 21, 2005. He was 88.

Born in Baltimore, September 3, 1916, he was the son of the late Edward Clinton, Jr. and Lydia Pearce Merryman. A graduate of Baltimore Public Schools, he served in the Army Air Corps during World War II. Following his release from active duty, he was employed by Westinghouse as a tool design engineer and supervisor until retiring in 1973. Following that retirement, he owned and operated an antiques business in Ellicott City known as "The Casual Manner Shop".

After the death of his wife, the former Helen M. Upman in 1974, he lived briefly in Florida before moving to Taylor's Island in Dorchester County in 1980. His hobbies included woodworking and refinishing antiques.

Mr. Merryman is survived by two daughters, Stephanie L. Hay of Annapolis and Diane M. Marquette and her husband, James, of Denton; a brother, Donald C. Merryman of Clearwater, FL and two grandchildren, Jessica Hay McCarthy and Michael Scott Hay.

Private services will be held at the Dulaney Valley Memorial Gardens.
