



## Minnie Kinsey

February 27, 1916 - October 18, 2008

Minnie Sherrill Kinsey of Chestertown, MD died on October 18, 2008 at Heron Point in Chestertown. She was 92.

Born on February 27, 1916 in Leavenworth, Kansas, she was the daughter of the late Clarence Osborne and Geraldine Caldwell Sherrill. She was the wife of the late Robert S. Kinsey.

Mrs. Kinsey was a graduate of Vassar College and Columbia Teachers College. She taught French at the Nightingale Bamford School in New York City until her retirement.
