



## Minnie Collier Warner

Minnie Collier Warner of Easton, MD, died on Thursday, March 29, 2001 at Memorial Hospital. She was 87.

Born June 10, 1913 in Talbot County, she was the daughter of the late Calvin, Sr. and Lula Jones Anderson. After graduating from Tri County High School, she took postgraduate courses at Easton High School. During her working years, she did bookkeeping at McCrory's and Rowens Stationary and did teller and receptionist work at Easton National Bank and Talbot Bank.

She was a charter member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, a life member of Miles River Yacht Club, a member of the Jr. Auxiliary at Memorial Hospital and Order of the Eastern Star. She was a former volunteer, assisting with the library, and supporter of The Country School.

Mrs. Warner's first husband, T. James Collier, whom she married April 4, 1934, died April 13, 1977. Her second husband, James Edgar Warner, whom she married March 19, 1982, died December 19, 1988. She is survived by a daughter, Joan Collier Fogg of Uniontown, PA; a sister, Beatrice Morgan of Easton, MD; two grandchildren, Samantha Adams Maylack of Portland Oregon and James Donovan Adams of Boston, Massachusetts. She was predeceased by three sisters, Virginia Wood, who died December 24, 2000, Ruth Reid, who died January 10, 1982, Suzy Dukes who died April 6, 1992;

three brothers, Calvin "Son" Anderson, Jr., who died in 1960, Sumner Anderson, who died December 24, 1979 and Chester Anderson, who died July 31, 1978.
