November 9, 1927 - January 2, 2009

Miriam (Mimi) Ingraham LeGates of Preston, MD died at the age of 81 on January 2, 2009 at the University of Maryland Hospital in Baltimore, MD. Mrs. LeGates was born in Rosemont, Pennsylvania on November 9, 1927, grew up in Easton, Maryland, and graduated from Easton H.S. She was a descendent of Colonel Prentiss Ingraham an Eastern Shore writer who wrote many adventure novels about Buffalo Bill as well as Land of Legendary Lore, a history of the Eastern Shore.

She was preceded in death by her husband John (Jack) S. LeGates, who was the First Selectman of Preston for 14 years, and also by a sister Prentiss Morgan of South Sioux City, Nebraska. She is survived by her sons, Stanton LeGates of Hurlock, Maryland, and John I. LeGates of Preston, Maryland, as well as by her sister Mary Ann Ingraham of Easton, second cousins Wayne Brown of Virginia and Charles Brown of California and numerous nephews and nieces including Miriam Stake of Minneapolis, Minnesota.

She was a devoted mother and wife. She will be deeply missed by all who knew her.
