Miriam McAllister Hall died Wednesday, October 11, 2000 in her apartment at William Hill Manor, Easton where she has lived since 1986.

Born on August 19, 1902 in Philadelphia, PA, she was the daughter of William G. & Bessie McAllister. She was graduated from West Philadelphia High School in 1920 and from Cornell University in 1924 where she was a member of Delta Delta Delta. She taught school at Clark Summit High School, Pennsylvania from 1924 to 1927 and Merchantville, NJ High School from 1927 to 1936. Her husband, Thomas L. Hall whom she married in 1936 died in 1983.

From 1936 to 1949 they resided in Upper Montclair, NJ and later in Morrisville, PA from 1949 to 1969 when they moved here to Easton, MD where she was active in the Women's Club of St. Michaels, the Talbot County Women's Club, the Half Miles (Women's Auxiliary of the Miles River Power Squadron) where she served as President for two terms. She was also a member of Edge Creek Boat Club and AARP.

Mrs. Hall is survived by her daughter, Elizabeth M. Hall of Verona, NJ and a grandson Michael Thomas Zeoli of Massachusetts, as well as two great-grandchildren, Alex and Ben Zeoli and her dear friends Lila Simmons & Rex Kilbourn.

She has been a member of the Presbyterian Church of Easton since 1969 where a Memorial Service will be held on Friday, October 13th at 2:00 PM and memorial donations may be made to the Talbot Hospice Foundation, 586 Cynwood Drive, Easton, MD 21601 or the Presbyterian Church of Easton, 617 N.
