



Moral William Trent

September 3, 1927 - February 29, 2012

Moral William Trent, better known as “Trent” died at his home on Wednesday, February 29, 2012. He was 84.

Born September 3, 1927, in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late William and Evelyn Jefferson Trent.

He grew up in New York City and enlisted in the Merchant Marines and served in the Army and was a Veteran of the Korean War. Following his release from active duty, he began working for a Lincoln/Mercury Dealer in Topeka, KS, where he learned the mechanical trade.

In 1970, he married Loreen Gray in Topeka, KS. In 1972, at the request of his family, he returned to the Maryland area and began working in construction and moved to Waldorf, MD, where he began a career in construction. He began building in an area on Kent Island, which later became Bay City and they moved to Centreville, and he retired in 1998 as a construction superintendent.

Trent enjoyed remodeling old cars.

In addition to his wife, Trent is survived by a niece, Lisa Brown and her husband, Alvin of Washington, DC.

His memorial service will be held at the Chester Church of God, Cox Neck Road, Chester, MD, on Saturday, March 24, 2012, at 2 p.m.
