Murray Saltzman of Stevensville, MD died Saturday, June 18, 2005 at his home. He was 76.

Born on May 24, 1929 in Jersey City, NJ, he was the son of the late, Benjamin Saltzman and Norma Wishner Saltzman. During his teens, he moved to Washington D.C. and later graduated from Evansville College located in Indiana. He enlisted in the United States Army, serving as a Ranger in the 101st Airborne during the Korean War. On February 14, 1957, he married the former, Norma I. Eash and they resided in Adelphi, MD later moving to Stevensville, MD in December of 1983. For 60 years of his life, Mr. Saltzman was employed as a sign artist.

Mr. Saltzman is survived by two sons, Sydney B. Saltzman and his wife, Susan of Millington, MD and Barry A. Saltzman of Stevensville, MD and three grandchildren, Benjamin A. Saltzman and Katherine C. Saltzman, both of Millington, MD and Jessica A. Saltzman of Stevensville, MD.

In November of 2002, his wife, Norma, of 45 years predeceased him.

A funeral service will be held at the family's home, 300 San Cedra Lane, Stevensville, MD 21666 on Wednesday, June 22, 2005 at 10:30am.
