She loved the water at her home and at Deep Creek Lake in Western, Maryland where she water skied for years. She spent many hours water color painting at home and with her painting friends. She was active in Great Books and loved the discussions there. She was active in the Community being one of the organizers of the Eastern Shore

Wine Society and first treasurer. She was also Secretary of the Easton Bird Club. She was known for her lovely smile and good humor and was felt to light up a room with her presence.

Her energy was boundless and she suffered multiple operations with no complaint and quick recovery. She was on the mend when a sudden downturn took her surrounded by her husband and family.
