



## Myrtle Alleen Bruscup

September 17, 1919 - April 10, 2021

While growing up in Baltimore City, Myrtle attended Eastern High School, where she graduated from in 1938. She then married Roland Oliver Bruscup on April 5, 1942. Together, they eventually moved to Mt Pleasant Beach in Pasadena in 1946.

After raising her family in Pasadena, Myrtle moved to Kent Island in 1982, where she resided until her passing. She was an active member of Galilee Lutheran Church. She was also very active in the Kent Island Heritage Society. Along with her husband and sister-in-law Audrey Hawkins, they often planned and volunteered for the annual Kent Island Days activities. She was even chosen as the Grand Marshal of the Kent Island Days parade in 2017.

Myrtle is survived by her two sons Ronald Roland (Lori) Bruscup of Grasonville, and Randy John (Stephanie Reuer) Bruscup of Annapolis, her grandson Air Force Staff Sergeant Nicholas Roland Bruscup, two nieces Virginia Ingling of College Park and her son Allen Ingling Jr. and Carol Rimkevicius of Baltimore City, and nephew Richard Schneider of Florida and his daughter Amy Schneider.

Along with her parents and husband, Myrtle is predeceased in death by her two sisters Ruth Elizabeth Schneider and Florence Matilda Edwardson-Dankmeyer as well as her niece Mary Ellen Eifert.
