



## Dr. N. Rachel Howland

January 10, 1952 - December 17, 2014

Queenstown, MD - N. Rachel Howland, MD died at her home on December 17, 2014.

Born in New York on January 10, 1952, she was the daughter of the late Angel Howland and Alice Picon Howland. She graduated from high school at age 15, and bought her first home at age 17. She later bought, remodeled and sold several other properties before she earned her Bachelor's Degree in Medicine, graduating Cum Laude from the Medical College of Georgia. She worked as a Physician's Assistant while she was pursuing her life-long dream of becoming a physician, graduating from Medical School after receiving training in England. Dr. Howland completed her residency in Internal Medicine and Pediatrics at the University of Oklahoma, during which time she spent two months on a Christina medical mission in India. Dr. Howland completed her Fellowship in Allergy and Immunology at Emory University in Atlanta, and became board certified in Allergy, Asthma and Immunology. Dr. Howland was active in clinical research and medical lecturing. Having suffered from asthma, allergies and eczema since childhood, she dreamed of opening her own practice to help those with whom she could so easily empathize. Dr. Howland first established her practice in Annapolis, MD, later moving to the Eastern Shore.

Dr. Howland is survived by her sister, Rachel Howland of Tampa, FL; and her

dear friend, Rich Brockley of Cambridge, MD. She was preceded in death by her parents, Angel and Alice Howland; and her brother, Kenneth Howland, who died in 2011.

A memorial service will be held at 2 pm on Sunday, December 21 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, MD, where friends and family may visit one hour prior to the service.

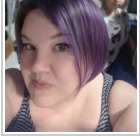

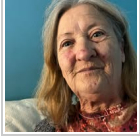

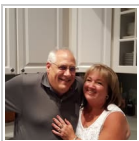
