



## Nan Bisland Meyer

October 9, 1916 - September 12, 2010

Nan Bisland Meyer of Annapolis, MD, formerly a 35-year resident of Richmond, VA, died Sunday, September 12, 2010. She was 93.

She was born October 9, 1916 in Natchez, MS, to the late, Anna Elliott Bisland and Edward Thompson. She was a direct descendent of Frederick Stanton who built the ante-bellum home in Natchez called "Stanton Hall," a National Historic Landmark. Nan was raised in New Orleans, LA, with her mother and stepfather, Arthur Duvic, Jr., and attended Sophie Newcomb College before transferring to LSU. She was the wife of the late, William R. Meyer, USN (Capt.ret.) to whom she was married for 55 years. As a Navy wife, Nan especially enjoyed living in France, Iceland and Guam. She loved writing and was active in the Romance Writers of America. She was a member of the DAR, the Colonial Dames and the Country Club of Virginia.

She is survived by two daughters, Rawle Mannix of Chester, MD, and Ann Elliott Carlsen and her husband, Roger of Annapolis, MD; a son, William Rhett Meyer, Jr. and his wife, Daria, of Boulder, CO; seven grandchildren, Anne Mannix, Christopher Mannix, Kevin Carlsen and his wife, Karen, Will Carlsen, Wesley Carlsen, Christopher Meyer, and Russell Meyer and his wife, Kristin; seven great-grandchildren, Nate, Kaelyn, Brianna, Brennan, Vanessa, Grace and Billy; and a half sister, Dorothy Paulet of Citrus Springs, FL.
