to playing the organ in church – Betterton UM and St. Clements Episcopal in Massey.

Equally passionate to gardening was her love for cooking. Nancy's favorite place was home, either in her gardens or in the kitchen. She was known for her yummy desserts, along with her giving heart – as she was constantly baking and blessing others with her sweet creations.
