Nancy Aitken Corbett, 82, of Grasonville, MD, died on Tuesday, November 15, 2011, at Corsica Hills Nursing Home.

Born in Stamford, CT, on January 26, 1929, she was the daughter of the late, Malcolm Thornton Aitken and Janet Hamilton Butler Aitken.
