



Nancy Carter Farrell

July 17, 1946 - October 3, 2025

Nancy Carter Farrell, of Sherwood, passed away on Oct. 3, 2025, she was 79 years old.

Born on July 17, 1946, in Brooklyn, NY, she was the daughter of the late George Valentine Cartwright Carter and Marie Jeanne (nee Nehrbas) Carter. She grew up in Greenlawn, Long Island, New York before moving to Llyod Harbor, New York.

Following high school Nancy attended Heidelberg University, in Tiffin, Ohio; before going on to work as a secretary for AT&T and later Airborne Instruments Lab (AIL).

At AIL, Nancy met the future love of her life, Thomas Farrell, to whom she married on October 1, 1977. Nancy and Thomas raised their family together in East Northport, NY and later Yorktown Heights, NY. When they moved to Northern Westchester, Nancy developed a music program for preschool children for the Yorktown Heights School District, where she taught the students both piano and guitar.

Together Nancy and Thomas' family grew to include their sons, Andrew Farrell and Christopher Farrell. Nancy gained six children when she married Thomas: Thomas, Jr. (Debra), Patrick (JoAnna), Brian (Charlotte), Joanne Forsyth,

Peter, and Timothy (Wendy).

Having found the Eastern Shore on an anniversary vacation, Nancy and Thomas moved to Sherwood in 2006.

Nancy is survived by her husband of 48 years, along with their children, and her beloved grandchildren, Christopher, Tillie, and Frankie to whom she was their "Amie"; as well her sister, Susan Thompson. Along with her parents, Nancy is preceded in death by her cousins, Allison Burrows and Mark Nehrbas.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, October 25, 2025, at 2pm at Christ Church, St. Michaels Parish, 301 S. Talbot St, St. Michaels, MD. Interment will take place at a later date in the family lots at Memorial Cemetery of St. John's, in Long Island, NY.
