Nancy Fitzpatrick, 69, of Queenstown died at Anne Arundel Medical Center on October 1, 2024.

Nancy was born in Baltimore, MD, on June 11, 1955, the beautiful daughter of John Robert Wilson and Ruth Elizabeth Wilson. Nancy attended Severna Park High School, followed by working for the Anne Arundel County Fire Department as a receptionist, which led to an administrative assistant position at the Arundel Center. She married her high school sweetheart, Bob, on September 18, 1977. In 1983, Nancy had her first born and became a homemaker. She enjoyed gardening and was active in her church. 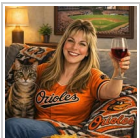
