Nancy Johnson Sandmann, 72, of Easton, MD, died August 28 at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, MD. After a short and courageous fight with lung disease, Nancy died peacefully surrounded by family.

Michael G. Sandmann's beloved wife of 50 years, Nancy was a resident of Easton since 1999. Nancy's love of life was legendary; she was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and friend. She was passionate about her family, and also about art, travel, food, literature, and the natural world around her. Her wit and encyclopedic knowledge made her a lively and entertaining conversationalist, for which she was well-known. She was the doting grandmother of Kaitlin, Natalie, Luke, Jack, and Will Sandmann, who were the light of her life and brought her so much joy.

Nancy's youngest son, Phillip K. Sandmann, preceded her in death in May 2009.
