Nancy W. Gent, a Phlebotomist at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital, passed away quietly at her home on the evening of June 15th after a long battle with cancer. She was a 60-year-old Kent County Native and married for 41 years to her husband, James Gent, Jr.
