Natalie Millhauser Adam of Easton, MD died on Sunday March 12, 2006 at William Hill Manor, Easton. She was 92.

Born November 23, 1913 in New York City, she was the daughter of the late Arthur W. and Lillian May Millhauser. She attended public school until the 8th grade and then studied at home with her governess. Her college studies were also completed at home. In her early 20's, she became a driver for the American Red Cross Volunteer Women Society Union. During World War II she drove with this group all over France, transporting many important people wherever they needed to be. After the war, she taught 3rd year hematolysis cases to nursing students and worked in various medical fields until meeting her future husband, Kurt Adam, a New York City artist-craftsman. They lived back and forth between New York and Oxford, MD for many years until Mr. Adam's death in the late 1970's. She had by then opened an antique shop in Trappe called Adam's Emporium. She ran the shop and did restoration work until her retirement in the mid 1980's.

Mrs. Adam has no immediate survivors.
