



Naylor W. "Bill" Ruppert

February 14, 1927 - September 24, 2013

Naylor W. "Bill" Ruppert, Jr., 86, of Stevensville, MD, passed away peacefully at his home on September 24, 2013.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on February 14, 1927, he was the son of the late Naylor W. and Virgie Specht Ruppert. Bill served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was honorably discharged in 1946. In 1948, he married the love of his life the former Peggy Joan Russell.

One of Bill's earliest jobs was at Thompson's Trailer in Pikesville, and then as a school bus driver for Baltimore County. Later, Bill worked in the family business, Ruppert Sanitation and with Westinghouse, where he worked for 20 years, retiring in 1980. After his retirement from Westinghouse, Bill continued to run the family business until 1996. The Rupperts set down roots on Kent Island in the early 80s.

Bill enjoyed spending time with his family playing competitive horseshoes, poker, backgammon, and hosting crab feasts. He also enjoyed boating, fishing, hunting, traveling, and gardening. Bill's love of the outdoors and the water transcended generations, influencing the lives of his children and grandchildren. Bill was a tireless father and grandfather, spending most of his life working two jobs, and yet always finding the time to spend with his family. He truly was one of a kind.

He is survived by his loving wife of 65 years, Peggy Joan Ruppert; his children, Diane C. Ruppert of Randallstown, MD, William D. Ruppert of Cooksville MD, and Cindy Ruppert of Stevensville, MD; a brother, Ernest Ruppert of Edgewater, MD; grandchildren, Jason Spires, Alison Nezbeth, Kelsey Como, and Kyle Ruppert; and a great-granddaughter, Brielle Marie Nezbeth. He was preceded in death by a son, David A. Ruppert, who died in 1999; and a brother, Edward K. Ruppert.
