



Nazmy E. Elehwany

September 6, 1927 - May 10, 2013

Nazmy E. Elehwany (“Naz”) of Oxford, MD, died on May 10, 2013, at Genesis Health Care, The Pines, in Easton, MD. He was 85.

Born in Cairo, Egypt, on September 6, 1927, he was the son of the late Elhami and Mofida Elehwany.

Dr. Elehwany received his B.S. degree in Chemistry at Cairo University in 1949. He came to America on a Fulbright Scholarship, attending the University of Maryland where he obtained both M.S. and PhD degrees in Food Science in 1955.

On December 26, 1960, he and Joan McGrath of Holyoke, MA, married. Before moving to Oxford, MD, he and his family lived in Spring Grove, PA, and Easton, MD. Naz worked as an Executive for Hanover Foods Corp. and was the owner of DelAgra Corp. in Bridgeville, DE. Naz was also a Consultant for US AID and the World Bank working on agribusiness projects in both Africa and Asia. He was also a member of the scientific advisory board to The Refrigeration Research Foundation and served as President of the Mid-Atlantic Food Processors Association. He finished his career as a Consultant and a Member of the Board of Directors of Hanover Foods Corp.

Naz loved his work, traveling, and spending time with his grandchildren.

He is survived by his wife, Joan; three children, David (Emily) of Chicago, IL, Michael (Maggie) of Annapolis, MD, and Laurice (Chris) Molinari of Los Angeles, CA; seven grandchildren; and his sisters, Laurice and Isis.

Naz was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Mary.
