July 12, 1937 - January 2, 2017

Neal Emerson Dyer, Jr., of Preston, MD, formerly of Arlington, VA, died at his home on January 2, 2017. He was 79.

Neal was born on July 12, 1937, to the late Neal E. Dyer, Sr. and Sarah M. White in Philadelphia, PA. He earned a B.A. in English from Lafayette College in 1960. He owned and operated two typesetting companies in Georgetown, Washington, DC. He later went to work for Todd Allan Printing in Maryland until retirement. After retiring, Neal and Sheila made their home in Preston, MD, in 2006.

He served in the Army Special Forces and Reserves. He was a member of the Lincoln Group of the District of Columbia and the Frederick Douglass Honor Society, St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Cordova, MD, and was also a member of the Knights of Columbus.

He was from a newspaper family and worked in the newspaper industry from high school through college. He read two newspapers a day. He was especially interested in Civil War history and history of the Eastern Shore. Neal enjoyed sailing and travelling. Neal and Sheila made frequent trips to Ireland to visit family. He was also a volunteer teacher of English as a second language.

Neal is survived by his wife of 41 years, Sheila Ward Dyer, and sisters, Sarah Dyer Pedraza and Patricia M. Dyer.

In addition to his parents, Neal was predeceased by his brother, Thomas A. Dyer.
