



Neil Roberts LeCompte

July 2, 1940 - December 8, 2017

Neil R. LeCompte of Centreville, MD, passed away on December 8, 2017, at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 77.

Born on July 2, 1940, in Vienna, MD, he was the son of the late Hamilton and Ruth Ryan LeCompte. He graduated from Wicomico Senior High School, Class of 1958, and then earned his teaching degree from Salisbury Teacher College. Neil taught school at the Wellwood School in Baltimore. In the early 1970's he returned to Salisbury University to receive his Certified Public Accountant degree. During his studies, he worked as Vice President of Peninsula Banks in Salisbury. In 1979 he moved to Centreville, MD. He worked as a managing partner of C.W. Amos & Company. From 1985 to 1988, he was CFO of Benson Motor Cars in Annapolis, MD. Mr. LeCompte started his own practice as Neil R. LeCompte CPA and retired in 2014.

Neil married Jean Wilson of Salisbury, MD, in 1978. He was a past member of Annapolis Rotary, Centreville Lions Club, and a member of American Mensa Foundation. He served on the Board of Directors of Centreville National Bank of Centreville, MD, and Shore Bancshares, Inc. of Easton, MD. He was a member of the American Mensa Society.

Neil is survived by his wife, Jean LeCompte of Centreville, MD; daughters Kelle Sparta (Jeff Brandon) of Boston, MA, Pamela Benitez (Michael) of

Annapolis, MD; son Scott Wilson (Carol) of Olney, MD; grandchildren, Zoe Benitez; Ella Benitez; Dana Wilson; Christopher Wilson; and Ian Wilson. He was predeceased by his sister, Lynn Dolbey.

A memorial mass on Friday, December 15, 2017, at 2:00pm at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Centreville, MD. A private interment will be in Chesterfield Cemetery.

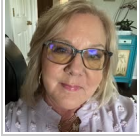
