



Nellie Holland Bartlett

October 18, 1927 - July 24, 2011

Nellie Gorman Holland Bartlett, 83, died Sunday, July 24, 2011, of pancreatic cancer at William Hill Manor in Easton.

Born Oct. 18, 1927, in Baltimore, she was the daughter of the late, Irvin Baxter Gorman and Nellie Hamill Gorman.

Known as Nonnie, she graduated from Roland Park Country School in Baltimore in 1945 and from Mount Holyoke College in South Hadley, MA, in 1949. She also earned a Master's of Education degree from the Johns Hopkins University in 1968.

She began her teaching career in 1949, working briefly at Friends School and Roland Park Country School before her marriage in 1950 to John Rich Holland Jr. She returned to the classroom in 1964 at Boys Latin School where she taught fourth grade until her retirement in 1983.

After retiring, she served as a docent at the Maryland Historical Society and was a member of the Maryland House and Garden Pilgrimage central committee, both in Baltimore.

She and Mr. Holland moved to William Hill Manor in Easton in 1998 where she became active with Trinity Episcopal Cathedral's chapel-of-ease at the

retirement community and volunteered at Easton Elementary School. Mr. Holland died in 2002.

She also was preceded in death by her second and third husbands, John M.R. Morton Jr. and Robert D. Bartlett Jr.

She is survived by three children, Elizabeth R. Holland of Princess Anne, John R. Holland III of Chicago and Jane H. Smith of Alberta, Ala.

A memorial service will be held Monday, August 1, 2011 at 10 a.m. at Trinity Episcopal Cathedral in Easton.

Burial will be at the Odd Fellows Cemetery in Smyrna, Delaware at 2 p.m.
