Nelson Herbert "Bud" Collins of Chestertown, Maryland died on Sunday, September 26, 2004 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, Maryland. He was 71.

Born in Rutherford, New Jersey on July 7, 1933, he was the son of the late Nelson Haley and Agnes Maier Collins. He was a 1951 graduate of Rutherford High School and a 1955 graduate of Williams College, where he earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics.

On November 11, 1955 he married Ann Wappler. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1955 until 1958 when he was honorably discharged as a Lieutenant J.G. He worked with Lear Siegler and Colt Industries before founding a manufacturing and engineering company in Rochester, New York. In 1992 he sold the company and retired to Chestertown. He enjoyed playing bridge, using his computer, and reading.

In addition to his wife of 48 years, he is survived by two daughters, Lynn McElin of Stillwater, Minnesota and Jennifer Toma of Arlington, Virginia; two brothers, John W. Collins of Cloverdale, California and Bruce M. Collins of Skillman, New Jersey, along with seven grandchildren.
