Newton Albert Lewis, Jr. of Rock Hall, Maryland died on October 31, 2006 at his home. He was 80.

Born in Newport, New Hampshire on August 30, 1926 he was the son of the late Newton Albert Sr. and Valmena E. Young Lewis.

He attended schools in Newport and graduated from Towle High School. He served in the Army Air Force in WWII in Rosewell, New Mexico. Mr. Lewis graduated from Keene State University with certification in Industrial Arts. He started teaching in Randolph, Vermont and Shelton, Connecticut, and finished in Trumbull, Connecticut.

Mr. Lewis received a 6th year certificate in guidance counseling from Fairfield University in Fairfield, Connecticut. He retired from teaching in 1984 from the Trumbull School System in Southern Connecticut. He will be remembered for setting up the industrial arts department at several new schools.

Mr. Lewis was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Chestertown, MD., a longtime member of the Ansonia Rod and Gun Club in Ansonia, Connecticut, and the Kent County Gun Club. He was also a member of the Connecticut Power Squadron. In addition to his teaching he was an accomplished cabinet maker and enjoyed fishing and boating.

In addition to his wife, Sarah (Sally) McManus Lewis he is survived by a son Newton E. Lewis of Montgomery Village, MD, two step children: Paul DeFilippes of Washington, DC and Portia DeFilippes of Bethesda, MD, a sister: Jean Ray of Franktown, Colorado, and two grandchildren Danny Hyatt

and Emma DeFilippes.

Services will be held on Saturday, November 4, 2006 at 12:00 noon at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Chestertown, MD.
