CWO 4 Nicholas Thomas Paul, U.S. Army retired, beloved father and patriarch passed away Saturday, March 3, 2012 surrounded by family and loved ones at Homestead Manor, Denton Maryland at the age of 95. A veteran of both WWII and the Korean conflict, he retired from the U. S. Army after 29 years of service and went on to work at the United States Postal Service for 12 more years.

Nicholas Paul was preceded in death by his wife of 43 years, Evelyn Maud Paul, his parents, Nicholas Stanley Paul and Stella Paul, and his grand daughter Kelly Creole Finlayson.

He is survived by his children: Christine Helfenbein and husband Alvin, Cynthia Cluck and husband Robert, Catherine Bryant, Nicholas Mark Paul, and Deborah Benedi, and 14 grandchildren, 12 great-grandchildren, and numerous nieces and nephews.
