A Funeral Liturgy for Nicholas O'Connor Coundjeris of Easton will be celebrated at Saints Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, where he was a member, on Saturday, December 28th at 10 A.M.

Mr. Coundjeris went home to the Lord on Friday, December 20, 2002 at his home after suffering a massive heart attack. He was 53.

Born at St. Joseph's Hospital in South Bend, Indiana on March 25, 1949, he was the son of Plato Nicholas and Jane Ellen O'Connor Coundjeris of Oxford.. After graduating from the Wolcott High School in Wolcott, CT in 1967, he attended the Cheshire Academy. In 1970, he moved with his family to Talbot County where he subsequently became the co-owner of the family business, The Aladdin Shop.

Throughout his life, he pursued many interests including photography and the study and appreciation of wildlife. He has brought joy and love to his family and friends, sharing his great and abiding faith in Jesus Christ.
