Nina Helen Coker Clinton passed away at her home on Tuesday, May 22, 2007 after a long illness. She was 81 years old.

Nina Clinton was born on August 25, 1925 and grew up in Gainesville, Georgia. She was a graduate of Gainesville High School. She would later meet Robert Paul Clinton in Virginia in 1947 and married him in 1950. They would make their home in Arnold, MD for 40 years where she raised her family and also worked as a copywriter for the Capital newspaper as the Name Dropper for 20 years before retiring in 1986. She enjoyed her grandchildren and spending time with her family. In 2006, she moved to Cordova to be with her family.

Nina Clinton is survived by 3 daughters, Kathleen Clinton of Baltimore, MD, Susan C.
