



Nolan Oliver Todd

March 18, 1937 - March 30, 2023

Nolan Oliver Todd died peacefully in his Easton, MD, home on March 30, 2023. He was 86 years old.

A lifelong resident of Easton, Mr. Todd was born on March 18, 1937, to Oliver and Katherine Higgins Todd. After graduating from Caroline High School in 1955, he spent his 40-year career as a technician in telecommunications, working for C & P Telephone and Verizon.

Mr. Todd was also a licensed pilot and boat captain, with boating safety a top priority. He loved boating and fishing, as well as working in his garden. He was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church of Easton.

He leaves behind his wife of 66 years, Betty; his four daughters, Rebecca Sarni (Dave), Katherine Lowery (J.R.), Mary Sue Brewer (Richard), and Norma Lee Todd (Bill); ten grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; and his sister, Donna Redden.

A visitation will be held at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, 100 Peachblossom Rd., Easton, on Tuesday, April 4 from 10 -11 a.m., followed by the funeral service at 11 a.m. Pallbearers will include Todd Lowery, Taylor Lowery, Justin Harrell, Nick Schuyler, Brandon Brewer, Rick Thorne and Matt DeGourse. 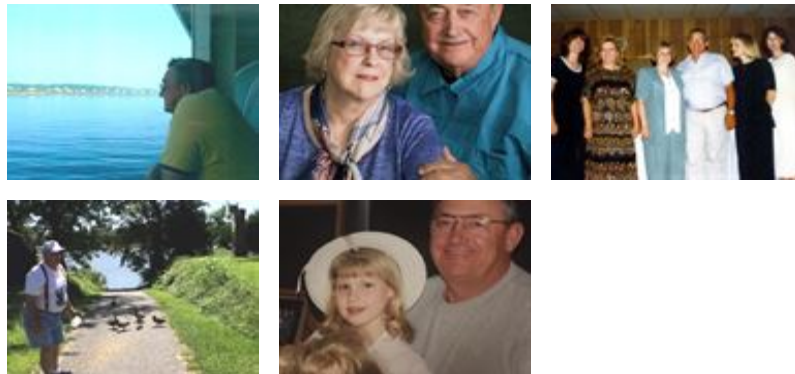

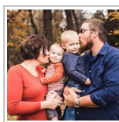
