September 10, 1925 - November 24, 2011

Norma D. Schumacher of Easton, MD, died November 24, 2011, at age 86 at William Hill Gardens.

Born Norma Jean Davis on September 10, 1925, in Painted Post, NY, she was a daughter of the late, Iris Louise Munn Davis and William Jey Davis. She was predeceased by four sisters, Lucille Hensley, Beverly Maszarose, Ruth Wade Wilson, Lyra Tucker, and a brother, Billy Davis .
