



Norma "Jean" Heflin

August 25, 1938 - February 24, 2010

Norma "Jean" Heflin of Centreville, MD died at the Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD on Wednesday, February 24, 2010. She was 71.

Born August 25, 1938 in Ridgely, MD, she was the daughter of the late, Carroll Alvin and Mary Helen Moore Usilton. She grew up in Queen Anne County and attended Centreville High School. On April 15, 1954 she married Haywood "Jack" Heflin and they resided in Fredericksburg, VA where she worked at G & H Sewing Factory. They then moved to Chesapeake Beach, MD where she was a homemaker. In 1978 they moved to Centreville, MD and she worked for Nationwide Fulfillment in Ridgely, MD until retiring in 1989. Mr. Heflin died in 1992.

She played bass fiddle with numerous bluegrass bands, loved sewing and spending time with her friends, family and especially her grandchildren. She also enjoyed traveling with her friends and family to the Bahamas.

Mrs. Heflin is survived by her twin daughters, Lisa Middleton and her husband, Scott of Centreville, MD and Tina Martin and her husband, Steve of Ingleside; three sisters, Helen Lee Badur of Millsboro, DE, Nancy Morris and Rebecca Chance, both of Centreville, MD; four grandchildren, Bryan and Colby Martin of Ingleside and Grayson and Jordan Middleton of Centreville, MD and numerous nieces and nephews. She was pre-deceased by a brother,
