Norma Louise Leonard Burroughs of Sykesville, MD died peacefully in her sleep at the Fairhaven Retirement Community in Sykesville, MD on Thursday, August 8, 2002. She was 93.

Born June 6, 1909 in Copperhill, TN, she was the daughter of the late Norman and Ida Marshall Leonard of Trappe, MD. Mrs. Burroughs was a teacher for over forty years, serving her profession in the public schools of Neavitt, Cordova, Sparks, Catonsville, MD and Torrington, CT. She spent her later years in her home on the Wye River with her sister, where she enjoyed crabbing, boating and waterskiing. She was an avid photographer and painter, studying art at the Kent Island Art League and at Fairhaven. Many of her paintings grace the walls there. Also at Fairhaven she founded the Square Dance Club and was an enthusiastic ballroom dancer.

Mrs. Burroughs is survived by two brothers, Norman H. Leonard, Jr. of Delaware, OH and James M. Leonard of Delmar, NY; six nieces and nephews and five great nieces and nephews. She was pre-deceased by her husband, Roy Burroughs and two sisters, Clara Leonard Glass and Katherine Marshall Leonard.
