



Norman "Bull" Donald Howeth Jr.

January 11, 1942 - February 21, 2021

Norman Donald Howeth, Jr. of Easton, MD, passed away on February 21, 2021, at his home, surrounded and cared for by loved ones. He was 79 years old. He was most notably known by the nickname of "Bull," a name he was given at a young age while growing up on Tilghman Island. He was also known as Donald or Don.

He was born on January 11, 1942, in Baltimore, the son of the late Norman Donald Howeth Sr. and May Virginia Watkins.

After graduating from St. Michaels High School, where he excelled in athletics, he attended College in Illinois and Baltimore. He later worked for the State of Maryland, Motor Vehicle Administration, retiring after 35 years of service. Following retirement, he enjoyed working in his garden, doing yard work, crabbing, watching his grandchildren participating in sporting events, and spending the winters in Jensen Beach, FL.

Bull is survived by his wife of 59 years, Kay Harrison Howeth; daughter, Lorri (Lara); son, Van (Kelly); grandchildren, Kayla (Donovan), Zach, Nathan, Noah, Ian; and a great-granddaughter, Kennedy. He was a wonderful husband, father, and "Poppy" who was dearly loved and will be missed by his family.

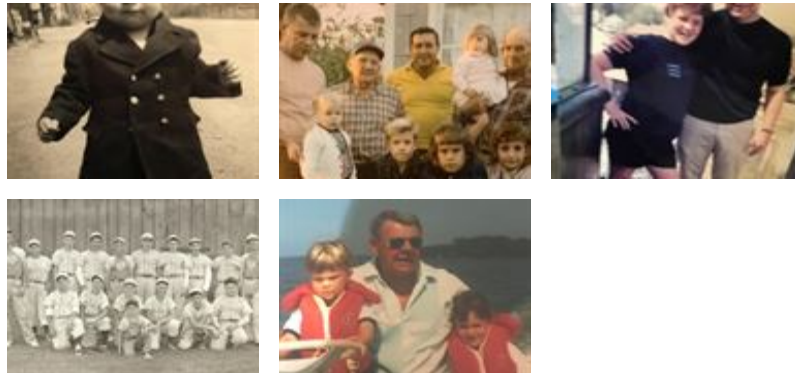

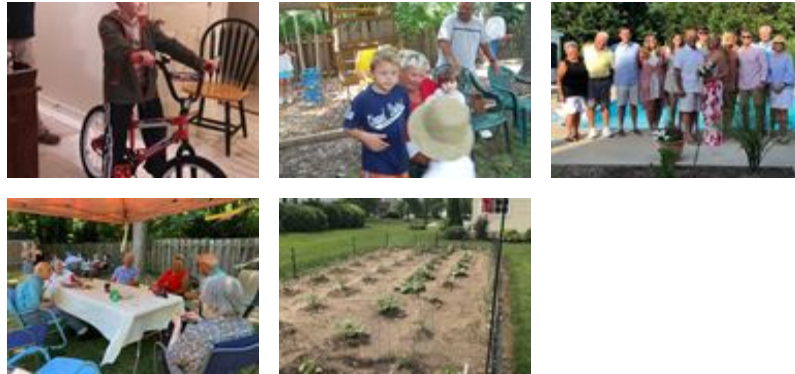
