May 20, 1940 - January 11, 2018

Norman Mott Shannahan, III, died on Thursday, January 11, 2018, at Mallard Bay in Cambridge, MD. He was 77.

Norman was born on May 20, 1940, in Baltimore, MD, to the late Norman Mott Shannahan, Jr., and Marion Ferguson.

Norman graduated from St. Michaels High School in 1958. He then attended Virginia Polytechnic Institute in Blacksburg, VA, and proudly served in the U.S. Army. For many years, he worked alongside his father and brother at Shannahan Artesian Well Company where he later served as President. After his retirement in 2005, Norman enjoyed golfing, fishing, boating, and spending time with his grandchildren.

Norman was a Mason, a member of Boumi Temple, St. Michaels Rotary, Miles River Yacht Club, Christ Church of St. Michaels, Easton Elks Lodge, and the Board of Directors for Mercantile Eastern Shore Bank.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Thelma Shannahan; daughters, Marion Shannahan Lewis of St. Michaels and Deborah Jane Mackendrick (David Ray) of Easton; grandchildren, Elizabeth Shannahan Lewis, Gillian Shannahan Lewis, and Christian David Mackendrick (fiancé, Erica Wiles); brother, Jack Shannahan (Faye M. Shannahan); and sister, Mary Jane Shannahan Wyant (Shannon Wyant), of St. Michaels.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, January 20, 2018, at 11:00 AM, at Christ Church in St. Michaels, MD. A private burial will be held at a later date.
